2015 NERRC Drivers Championship Rules

Driver Eligibility

- Drivers holding valid SCCA Competition Licenses or certain drivers with Novice Permits, and all others allowed to compete in SCCA events, per the current GCR.
- Drivers must compete in an eligible car of the same class in at least 4 weekends during the 2015 NERRC Race schedule.

Car Eligibility

- While competing for points, each car must visibly display the 2015 NERRC Championship stickers provided by Thompson Speedway Motorsports Park on each side of the vehicle. Placement to be decided by the car owner.
- All GCR recognized regional classes plus:
 - o CFC Club Formula Continental
 - o NCF NARRC Club Ford
 - ITE Improved Touring E
 - o IT7 Improved Touring 7 with Nitto NT-01 tires
 - SSM Showroom Spec Miata
 - SM2
 - SPO Super Production Over
 - o SPU Super Production Under

The 2015 NERRC DRIVERS CHAMPION will be decided by the highest total points accumulated in each class per the current scoring rules. Each eligible class champion will win a Test Day or Club Day for use in 2016 at Thompson Speedway Motorsports Park courtesy of Thompson Speedway Motorsports Park, along with a Trophy TBD by New England Region. - Weekend 1 -- May 23rd & 24th New Hampshire Motor Speedway (Combined with *NARRC* and *NEDIV* championship series)
- Weekend 2 -- June 19th & 20th Lime Rock Park (Combined with NARRC and NEDIV championship series)
- Weekend 3 -- July 10th & 11th Thompson Speedway Motorsports Park (Combined with *NARRC* championship series)
- Weekend 4 -- August 1st & 2nd New Hampshire Motor Speedway
- Weekend 5 -- August 22nd & 23rd Palmer Motorsports Park
- Weekend 6 -- September 12th & 13th Palmer Motorsports Park (Combined with *NARRC* championship series)

2015 Scoring Rules

- Your best 12 finish points in class for the year will count towards your points for the championship.
 - o Finish points are calculated for each "NERRC Race" and do not include qualifying or practices.
- The last NERRC race of the <u>Championship weekend</u> at Thompson Speedway Motorsports Park is worth Double Points. The other "NERRC Races" that weekend will be worth normal points.

⁻For a DNF you are awarded points accordant to your DNF finishing position in class.

Tie Breakers will be determined by adding your next, highest finish points until a winner is determined. Example: If when calculating your best 12 finishes you and any number of other drivers are tied, then a 13th race finish will be counted to see if a winner is determined. If a tie still exists, 14 races will count. This process will continue until a winner is chosen.

OTHER ITEMS

Point loss from exclusions, disqualifications, protests, etc. may parallel GCR National event rules. The voting NER CRB will rule on situations not in the GCR. All non-GCR regional class rules can be found at www.narrc.com
